As we looked and prayed over the list of names, we noticed that about 40% of the international students were from countries that are full of unreached people groups – places like Saudi Arabia, India, Japan, Egypt, and several more.

Realizing the amazing opportunities the Lord had given us, our BSU began developing relationships with many international students in the hopes of developing lifelong friendships and having Gospel conversations. Through game nights, weekend road trips, coffee hangouts, and late night Walmart runs, the Lord allowed us to befriend and share the Gospel with over 40 international students this past year, three of whom made decisions to follow Jesus!
