Messengers tap Columbus pastor as new MBC president

Judson W. "Bill" Hurt, senior pastor of Pleasant Hill Church, Columbus, was elected without opposition to a first term as president of the Mississippi Baptist Convention (MBC) at the Oct. 24 morning session of the 2023 Annual Meeting at First Church, Jackson.

He replaces Lloyd Sweatt, pastor of Meadowood Church, Amory, who completed his second term and was not eligible for reelection.

In the only contested election of 2023, messengers chose David Haynes, senior pastor of Trinity Church, Fulton, for a first term as second vice-president over Gary Wyatt, retired pastor and member of North Morton Church, Morton.

Both Recording Secretary Michael Weeks, pastor of Pleasant Hill Church, Olive Branch, and Associate Recording Secretary Will McNeese, senior pastor of Polkville Church, Polkville, were reelected without opposition.

Messengers also approved a 2024 Cooperative Program budget of \$30,890,325, an increase of \$213,945, or .7%, over the 2023 budget. The portion going to Southern Baptist Convention causes for 2024 represents 39.25% of the total 2024 budget, or \$12,124,453, an increase of 1.34%, or \$160,665, more than the 2023 budget.
