Blue Mountain's Dr. Ronald Meeks, Chair and Professor of Biblical Studies, as well as Director of Church Relations and Ministerial Recruiting, will edify attendees with an effective preaching strategy for 1 and 2 Samuel.

"Our Preaching Conference will feature presentations by some of the leading Bible scholars in our state that will examine and analyze the background and theological lessons of 1 and 2 Samuel and provide powerful preaching and teaching ideas on applying these truths to our daily lives of faith and ministry," said Dr. John Pace, Director of the MBCB Leadership Department.
