

Special concert to close out SMACK children's worship camp

JACKSON, Miss. (Special) – The 140 participants in the 2023 Mississippi Baptist Summer Music and Arts Camp, known as SMACK, will premiere Celebration Station, a new children's musical from Llilenas Music, during the camp's closing worship concert on July 14 at Baptist-affiliated William Carey University in Hattiesburg.
